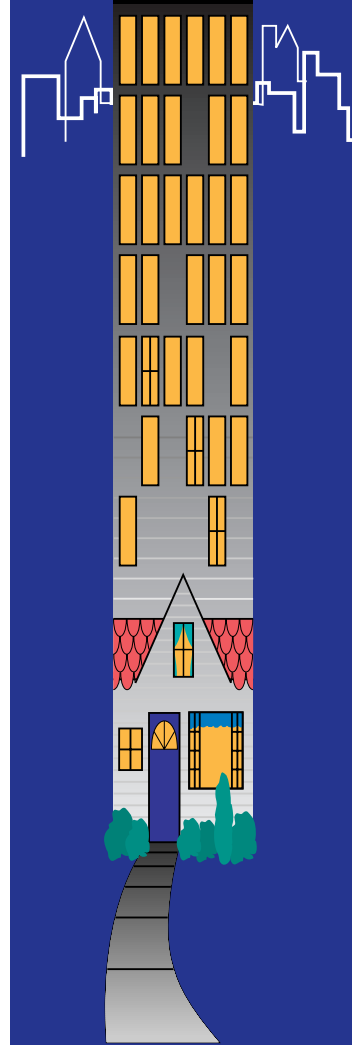

She currently serves on the Board of Directors of the College and University Work/Family Association and is a Dean for Academic Support at Pasadena City College.

C. COLEMAN GRIFFITH, ARCHITECT Is Assistant Professor of Architectural Design at Pasadena City College. He brings 12 years of professional architectural design experience in various areas including institutional buildings such as libraries, elementary schools and learning centers. He is a California registered architect and is NCARB certified. He holds a MA in Urban Design and Architecture from Ohio State University.

DR. DIANNE L. PHILIBOSIAN has been a professor and administrator at California State University, Northridge since 1973 and is currently on a professional development leave to serve as a Regent of the University of the Pacific, Stockton, California. In addition to her academic experience, she is very active in the child care community and serves as a Governor's appointee to and past chair of the State of California Child Development Policy Advisory Committee, and previously as an appointee to the City of Los Angeles Child Care Advisory Board. She has been an active advocate for high quality child care as she participates in the formulation of legislation and works closely with local elected officials.
